

**Pierre Bricage, retired professor**

Graduated in Genetics, Embryology and Biochemistry at the University of Paris (France), working in Agronomy, Ecology, Plant Physiology and Microbiology, first at the University of Dakar (Senegal), then in Animal EcoPhysiology, Health Sciences, Applied Informatics and Data Bases Analysis at the University of Pau (France), since 1972, as researcher and teacher, on average, he published each year 1 teaching practice manual, 2 higher education lecture notes, 2 education research papers for teachers' training (UNESCO), 2 papers in international journals or books, 1 technological transfer paper in industrial competitions (awards, patents, NATO conferences), with 2 talks. Since 2000, as AFSCET Vice-President (<http://afscet.asso.fr>), he co-organized congresses, edited publications, in Systems Science, and developed the new paradigm of ARMSADA (<http://armsada.eu>).
