Dr. Terry Weech is an Associate Professor and at the Graduate School of Library and Information Science, University of Illinois. He has served as Chair of the International Federation of Library Associations (IFLA) Division of Education and Research, the Chair of the IFLA on Education and Training Section and the Chair of IFLA Library Theory and Research Section. He is currently a member of the IFLA Section on Library Theory and Research' Standing Committee and a member of the ALA Committee on Accreditation which oversees the American Library Association's accreditation program of LIS education in the U.S. and Canada. His research interests include collection development, library systems and networks, library administration, economics of information, government information resources, and library education with a special focus on education for digital librarianship. Internationally he has lectured in more than twenty countries. He currently teaches courses dealing with Library Administration, Library Cooperation, International Librarianship, the Economics of Information and Librarianship and Society.
